CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The 2017 MTOA Conference will be held October 23-25 at the Southaven Police Departments Range. **ON Monday October 23 Registration will be held at 11:00 AM at the Range.** Monday will be training from 12:00 pm to 6 PM and competition events will be held on Tuesday and Wednesday. On Wednesday following the last event around 2 PM we will have a Banquet and Awards Ceremony at the range.

We will be trying a different format for events this year. Entry Team and Snipers will be combined as a team for all events. Each team can be up to 6 people max and 4 people minimum. All events will take 4 team members. If you have a 6 man team you can substitute and swap out members as you see fit. The events will have stages where utilizing a sniper would be best for the team. This will be left up to the team leaders on who to use where.

Training

Snipers

23OCT2017 (MONDAY)-Training day. All personnel attending conference must attend training. Group Sniper training will run from 1200-1800, break for dinner (will be provided on site) and start competition events with night fire.

Entry

23OCT2017 (MONDAY)-Training day. All personnel attending conference must attend training. Group training will run from 1200-1800, break for dinner (will be provided on site) and start competition events with night fire.

Combined Entry/Sniper Competition

24OCT2017 (TUESDAY)-Competition starts. 0800-1800 (Lunch will be provided on site. There will be a dinner / social after events are completed for the day.)

25 OCT 2017 (WEDNESDAY)-Competition continues. 0800-1300. Awards and Banquet at 1400 at the range.

All Events, Banquet and Awards should be over by 1600 hrs on Wednesday October 25th.

2017 MTOA Swat Competition Events:

3 Gun Match

A 3 Gun Course will be run continuously on Range 1 for the duration of the competition. Competitors can run the course for a cost of \$5, and there is no limit to the times a competitor can run the course. The competitor with the fastest time will win the pot.

Monday (Day 1)

The Lumberjack:

3 man event

3 team members will attempt to cut a 4x4 wooden post in half using a rifle (5.56) or sub gun (9mm or .40), pistol and a pump shotgun (buckshot). Fastest time wins.

Equipment needed:

Rifle (5.56) or sub gun (9mm or .40) and ammo

Shotgun (pump) and buckshot ammo

Pistol and ammo

Night Shoot

4 man event

Course of Fire:

5 yd. line

IALEFI-Q Target

3 on the tree - 3 to body rifle, transition to handgun, 3 to head pistol - 6 seconds

Uno, Dos, Tres - 1 to head rifle, rifle goes to bolt lock, transition to pistol, 2 to body pistol, transition to rifle, combat reload rifle, 2 to body rifle & 1 to head rifle - 11 seconds

Now drill - 15 to body pistol, combat reload pistol, 1 to head pistol - 11 seconds

2 fast - 2 to head rifle, rifle goes to bolt lock, combat reload rifle, 4 to body rifle, transition to pistol, 2 to head pistol, pistol goes to slide lock, combat reload pistol, 4 to body pistol - 15 seconds

2 furious - 10 to body rifle, transition to pistol, 10 to body pistol - 10 seconds

Equipment needed:

Rifle and ammo

Tuesday (Day 2)

Spartan Shoot

4 man event

Team members will compete in a relay event, shooting from 50 yards and in with pistol and carbine from multiple shooting positions (prone, kneeling, standing, and on the move) in a gas mask. The event will be scored on accuracy and combined time.

Equipment needed:

Gas Mask

Rifle and ammo

Pistol and ammo

Mayhem

4 man event

Team members will have to engage a long range target, and then maneuver to pre-determined positions, where a different team member will engage targets at each position. Team members will have to recover equipment throughout the course of fire and return it to the finish line.

Equipment needed:

Rifle and ammo

Pistol and ammo

Officer Down

4 man event

Team members will have to navigate through tight, confined space, in low light. Locate and package a rescue dummy for extraction. Engage targets from high angle. Extract the rescue dummy to the safe area.

Equipment needed:

Rifle and ammo

Pistol and ammo

John Wick

4 man event

Team members will engage a target from an aerial platform. Navigate tight spaces and engage target at close ranges with pistol. Manipulate heavy weighted bag. Utilize barricades and engage targets at intermediate range with shotgun. Manipulate heavy weighted bag. Utilize vehicles and engage targets at intermediate range with rifle. Manipulate heavy weighted bag to safe area.

Rifle and ammo

Pistol and ammo

Shotgun and ammo

Long Range

Team members will engage a series of targets ranging from 100 to 400 yards using multiple alternate firing positions.

Equipment needed:

Rifle and ammo

The Brakes Run

Team members will have to negotiate a series of obstacles carrying an item of significant weight, climb to an elevated position and engage targets at varying distances with pistol and rifle.

Equipment needed:

Pistol and ammo

Wednesday (Day 3)

The Iron Man

The Iron Man is an extremely physical one man event. The event results will not count towards the Team scores. The event will combine shooting, rappelling, running and climbing. All Officers from each Team can compete on an individual basis if wanted (up to 6 per Team).

The Team Run

The Team Run will be the final 4 man event where competitors can expect to run, carry heavy equipment, shoot and any combination of the prior events.
