SAFETY AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

1. Competitors will report to the range with a safe (unloaded) and properly functioning weapon and FACTORY MATCH GRADE AMMUNITION (NO HANDLOADS) designed for their weapon system.
2. Competitors will not load weapons until told to do so by the range officer.
3. When on the firing line, all weapons will be pointed down range at all times.
4. Upon the command of “cease-fire”, competitors will immediately stop firing and make their weapon safe.
5. NOBODY will move down range until the firing line is declared safe by the range officer.
6. Competitors will wear eye/ear protection while on the firing line.
7. Competitors will notify the range officer of any weapon malfunctions.
8. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited on the range.
9. Safety is everyone’s concern. All competitors are responsible for immediately reporting any unsafe acts or conditions to the range officer.
10. When not in use, all weapons will be unloaded and properly secured.
11. Tampering with any other competitor’s gear will result in immediate dismissal from the event.
12. Violation of any of the above rules may result in the competitor being dismissed from the competition with no refund.

The North American Sniper Conference (NASC) will be a physically demanding rifle competition that will include the use of high-powered rifles and physical activity such as running, crawling, and jumping. I certify that I am in good health and have the physical ability to compete safely. I understand and will abide by the above safety guidelines. In the event that I am injured, I hereby fully release the Mississippi Tactical Officers’ Association, Southaven Police Department, the Desoto County Sheriff’s Office and any persons working in a staff or range officer capacity, both individually and as a group, from any liability.

DATE/TIME/LOCATION: THE 2021 NASC will be held at Deep South Tactical Training Complex located at 2500 Section Road, Terry, MS 39170. On Sunday, March 28, 2021, Deep South Tactical Training Complex will have a 100 yard range available for use for any zero conformation needed. This will also be sign in times for competitors and vendors. NASC will begin on Monday March 30, 2020 at 0800 and conclude on Wednesday, March 31, 2020 with an awards banquet.

ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS: THE 2021 NASC is open to all full-time police and military personnel who have primary or additional duties in a sniper/observer capacity. The competition is also open to law enforcement/military personnel who have retired in good standing. We will also have separate category for Vendor / Sponsor Teams. These teams must adhere to the same restrictions as all military / LE teams. **Registration paperwork must be returned no later than March 27, 2021.**

ENTRY FEE: The cost for each two-man team is \$400.00. Each additional team from the same agency will be discounted \$50.00. Payments are due by in-processing on March 27, 2021 unless other arrangements have been made with NASC staff. Each competitor will receive an official 2021 NASC t-shirt. *Be sure to include your t-shirt size on the registration form.* Vendor / Sponsor teams will have additional fees (See Vendor / Sponsor packet)

RELEASE OF LIABILITY/SAFETY AGREEMENT: Each competitor must execute a Release of Liability/Safety Agreement form and return it with the registration paperwork. Teams will also sign the same paperwork for Deep South Tactical Training Complex upon arrival.

LODGING: Byram, MS has several hotels and is within 20 minutes of the range. Most do offer Mil/LE discount. Competitors are responsible for lodging cost.

TRAVEL: Terry, MS is located south of Jackson, MS (Approximately 35 minutes) and approximately 20 minutes from Byram, MS, where most lodging is located. Please contact us if you need help.

MEALS: Lunch each day will be provided on site. There will be a social event Tuesday evening March 30th and dinner will be provided.

IN-PROCESSING: In-processing will be held at the Deep South Tactical Training Complex on Sunday, March 28, 2021 from 1700-1900 hours. At 1800 hours, there will be a competitor briefing at the facility. Late arrivals need to notify NASC staff member.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS: It is the responsibility of each competitor to furnish all equipment and ammunition needed for the competition. Each competitor will need a minimum of 250 rounds of rifle ammunition and all call-out gear to include eye and ear protection. Handguns and carbines (patrol rifles) will be provided by the staff in this year's competition. Both Law Enforcement/Military teams and Vendor Teams must utilize calibers between .223 and 300 wind mag. If your department or unit issues another caliber you wish to shoot with please contact us prior to arrival. Please contact staff for questions. Extra ammunition is suggested as there will be open range time as well as classes available.

ALL AMMUNITION USED DURING THE COMPETITION MUST BE FACTORY AMMUNITION. NO HANDLOADED AMMUNITION WILL BE ALLOWED. AMMUNITION IS SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY RANGE OFFICERS.

AWARDS BANQUET: The 2021 NASC awards banquet will be held on March 31, 2021, and location TBD. Trophies, plaques, cash prizes and gear will be awarded to the top teams and individuals. Law enforcement vendors are invited to show gear during the week and at the banquet.
