CLASSES

Monday, October 23 - Mid-South Shooting Institute Pistol/Rifle Clinic

Instructor – Scott Hatfield – Tier 1 Combat Shooting, LLC

Scott Hatfield spent 17 years as a Navy SEAL (eight of those years at SEAL Team 6). Scott has spent the past 13 years as a lead instructor in Mid-South Combat Shooting, teaching Special forces, FBI, other agencies, and Law enforcement personnel. Scott started Tier 1 Combat Shooting, LLC about five years ago, because he saw the need to provide better weapons handling for the law enforcement community. He has traveled all around to different law enforcement departments to provide this and other tactical training. Shooting and tactical training is Scott's passion and he wants to give back to those that are out on the streets daily, having to make life or death decisions.

Instructor – Joe Rhoades – Red Beard Shooting Solutions, LLC

Lead Instructor and owner of Redbeard Shooting Solutions, Joe Rhoades, has been actively involved in the firearms training industry for several decades. Joe became an NRA certified rifle instructor at 15 with a near perfect scores. Joe received a degree in Occupational Studies in Gunsmithing from the world-renowned Colorado School of Trades in Lakewood, Colorado at the age of 20. From late 2007 thru early 2023, Joe was a Lead Instructor at the Mid-South Institute of Combat Shooting in Lake Cormorant, MS. His time there allowed his level of mastery to excel. While at Mid-South, Joe was a lead instructor for numerous military Special Operations units and as well as several agencies that conduct both covert and clandestine operations in furtherance of US foreign policy.

EQUIPMENT: Duty or tactical belt and holster, pistol with magazines and mag pouch, rifle, sling, magazines, and mag pouches, eye and ear protection. Anything else is shooter preference.

Recommend a range chair, water, and extra batteries.

AMMO: 500 rounds of pistol ammo, 500 rounds of rifle ammo

Tuesday, October 24 – In Extremis Performance Dynamic Shooting

Instructor – Jake Labhart – In Extremis Performance, LLC

The IEP team teaches across the country with special operations units to enhance operational readiness. Their team is comprised of human performance experts, competition shooters, and SWAT operators. This diversity brings a specialized approach to dynamic shooting for the special operations community.

An IEP course is built entirely around movement, focusing on moving to/from a position with speed and power, while accurately putting rounds on target. Additionally, the course will highlight skills and techniques to confidently shoot while moving.

This course will teach the shooter how to train with purpose, while focusing on the specific job requirements of a SWAT operator. Each shooter will be pushed to find where they can effectively operate a firearm with a high degree of speed and accuracy.

EQUIPMENT: Rifle w/ sling: 350 rounds (minimum), Pistol: 350 rounds (minimum), belt with holster and mag pouches, range attire (gear for the weather), water bottle

Wednesday, October 25 – Competition

Entry Team and Snipers will be combined as a team for all events. Each team can be up to 6 people max and 4 people minimum. All events will take 4 team members. If you have a 6-man team you can substitute and swap out members as you see fit. The events will have stages where utilizing a long range weapon system would benefit the team. This will be left up to the team leaders on who to use and where.

EQUIPMENT:

- Uniform / clothing of your choice
- Footwear (no open toe shoes)
- Jacket / rain jacket (weather dependent)
- Ballistic helmet
- Gas mask w/filter
- Ballistic eye protection
- Hearing protection
- Tactical vest / plate carrier w/plates and ammo bearing pouches
- Carbine or SMG w/sling
- Pistol w/holster
- Gloves

AMMO:

Per team

- 1000 rounds ammunition, Carbine or SMG minimum (bring more if available)
- 1000 rounds ammunition, Handgun minimum (bring more if available)
