In the event that I require medical care or treatment, I agree to be financially responsible for any cost as a result of said treatment. I am aware and understand that I should carry my own medical insurance.



DCSD/MTOA BASIC SNIPER COURSE OVERVIEW

The MTOA BASIC SNIPER COURSE (40 hour, 1-week course) is designed to give team members the skills necessary to successfully integrate into law enforcement tactical units.

The live fire and classroom portions of this course will be held at the Southaven Police Dept. training range. We will travel to an additional location (if available) for the extended range training. Each day of the course will consist of both classroom instruction and live fire. On the range, we will experience a variety of targets, techniques, scenarios and distances. Once all equipment is zeroed, shooters will engage steel and paper targets from distances of 25 to 800 yards.
